A special meeting of the Council was called to order at 4:00 o'clock P.M. for the purpose of discussing the thorne-Petrovich portion of the water bond issue and discussion of water contract with the Jesse Lee Home. Mayor Painter in the chair. Present were Cm. Stockton, Rose, Watsjold, Werner and Gus Johnson. Absent Cm. C. E. Johnson.

Cm. Werner moved to pay the balance of the Thorne-Petrovich contract in full upon receipt of the bond money. Seconded by Cm. Gus Johnson. All in favor, motion carried.

Mr. Mathews and Mr. Lee of the Jesse Lee Home were present regarding the water contract and tanks and stated the agreed term was for twenty five years rather than the ten years stated in the contract.

Cm. Gus Johnson moved that the Jesse Lee Home contract for water read twenty five (25) years as already agreed upon instead of the ten years as written. Seconded by Cm. Stockton. All in favor, motion carried.
